#MaVoix

In 5 years, Quebec will have more seniors aged 65 and older than youth aged 20 and under. An array of social, economic, technological and environmental issues are awaiting the next generation, so they need to be given a voice to share their ambitious, innovative, participatory and impactful initiatives!

The Réseau des carrefours jeunesse-emploi du Québec's Ma Voix Compte! initiative is a powerful way for youth to participate in concrete social change projects implemented by them, for them. It's a movement that gives youth a voice and allows them to play a key role in Quebec's development.

It's a major public consultation process about emerging issues that do and will need action. Various consultation methods were used to allow participants and partners from all walks of life to discuss central themes. Locally, youth employment centres (carrefours jeunesse-emploi) and their partners consulted the youth in their areas. Their work was paired with a large online survey.

Ma Voix Compte! gives youth the chance to participate, learn, share their ambitions and start discussions about the issues they face. It's a movement that gives them the chance to act and allows them to get involved with youth politics.

Youth shared their concerns about increasing individualism and their feelings of powerlessness. They also showed that they wish to work together, actively participate in projects and make a real impact on their world.

As a society, let's build the future together by giving youth a voice and supporting them in their projects. Let's work towards sustainable communities, where innovations and technology work together to advance humanity.
