COVID-19 INFORMATION EASTERN TOWNSHIPS

QUEBEC GOVERNMENT DIRECTIVES

A state of health emergency has been declared in the province:

- ban on visits to CHSLDs and hospitals
- ban on indoor gatherings of more than 250 people
- schools, cegeps, universities and daycare centers are closed until March 29
- residents aged 70+ are asked to stay in their homes

Closures:

- libraries
- theatres/cinemas
- public pools/spas/saunas
- bars/dance halls/arcades
- buffets & sugar shacks
- **CANADIAN GOVERNMENT DIRECTIVES**

Global Travel Advisory

 avoid non-essential travel to all destinations outside of Canada until further notice

Canadians Abroad

- return to Canada while commercial options remain available
- register with the Government of Canada if you have no immediate plans to return



WHEN IN PUBLIC TO DO GROCERIES. GO TO WORK, VISIT A PHARMACY OR **SEEK MEDICAL CARE:**



- restaurants must operate at 50% capactiy
- museums

- ski hills
- gyms & arenas



No symptoms: Maintain a distance of **1 metre** between yourself and others

With symptoms: Maintain a distance of 2 metres between yourself and others



WHO NEEDS TO SELF-ISOLATE?

Voluntary:

- anyone returning to the country from an international destination
- people with active symptoms

Mandatory:

• anyone working in the public service, health and social services, education and child care sectors

WHO CAN GET TESTED?

- 1. You are returning from a trip outside Canada
- 2. You have one or more of the following symptoms:
 - a. Fever
 - b. Cough
 - c. Breathing difficulties
- 3. Your symptoms started within 14 days of returning from the trip.

TEST CENTRE HOURS

As of March 14, 2020 test centres are open **7 days a** week from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. and will remain open for an undetermined length of time.



TEMPORARY WORKER ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

- who have the virus
- who have active symptoms of the virus
- who were in contact with an infected person
- or who are returning from outside of Canada

Collaboration with the Red Cross to proceed by bank deposit or prepaid card (to avoid travel). who are not eligible for compensation via
