

In the Eastern Townships, the health and social service fields offer an interesting variety of career opportunities for both English- and French-speaking individuals who want a career that focuses on human well-being.


If you are passionate about helping others, learning new skills, and staying current on constantly evolving medical trends, treatments, and discoveries, then a profession in the health and social services might be right for you!

Access to Health and Social Services Training



This guide will answer your questions on how to pursue a career in the Eastern Townships. The training requirements for each career vary tremendously. However, many of the career training programs included in the catalogue are available in this region, making it easier for you to explore your options. This guide is designed to help you make the most of the journey towards your career by providing you with the most pertinent and recent information.

How to use this guide

On each career page, you will find a small job description, and resources and information on where training is offered. The options for training are limited to the career itself. Institutions located in the Eastern Townships are listed first (when applicable), followed by programs that offer English-language training. French-language programs in schools located outside the Eastern Townships region are listed last. If access to training is limited, then options for training outside the province of Quebec are also listed.

Note: Training options vary by career; it is possible that no training is currently available in the Eastern Townships—or even in Quebec—for some careers.





1.1 General Practitioners and Family Physicians



Training

To become a general practitioner or family physician in Quebec, you must: (2)

- Obtain a bachelor's of science degree (or have completed a college program and one year of pre-medicine university studies).
- Graduate from an approved medical school and complete the required residency training.
- Complete the certifying examinations given by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada—and be licensed by the Collège des médecins du Québec.



1.2 Specialist Physicians



Training

To become a specialist physician in Quebec, you must: (2)

- Obtain a bachelor's of science diploma (or have completed a college program and one year of pre-medicine university studies).
- Graduate from an approved medical school and have specific specialty training.
- Complete the certifying examinations given by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada—and be licensed by the Collège des médecins du Québec.
- Complete the training required for certification in your chosen specialty field according to requirements of the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada/Collège des médecins du Québec.

- Be registered with the Ordre des infirmières et infirmiers du Québec.



2.2 Specialized Nurse Practitioner



Training

To become a specialized nurse practitioner, you must: (2)

- Obtain a graduate degree (Master's) in your chosen specialty.
- Pass the Ordre des infirmières et infirmiers du Québec exam in order to practice your specialty.

In the province of Quebec, this program is offered in several universities according to the specialty you choose.

Class 3: To be classified as a Class 3 educator, you must have a Grade 11 diploma recognized by the *Ministère de l'éducation*, *du loisir et du sport*.






