ELIGIBILITY

This contest is open to all secondary students (public, private or homeschool) in the Eastern Townships region's English-speaking community, who also meet the following criteria:

- Attending an English-language high school in the historical Eastern Townships, or if homeschooled, their education was predominantly in English;
- Graduating in the 2019-2020 school year;
- Accepted* to a post-secondary institution (college/CÉGEP, vocational or technical training) in the Estrie.

**Please note winners will be required to provide proof of application before claiming their award.*

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ENTRY & GUIDELINES

Submit your entry for one of the two categories (written or video).

There are **two parts** to this challenge, both must be included in the essay:

Part 1) **Tell us about your experience as a member of the region's English-speaking community:**

- Did you overcome any obstacles on your path to graduation? Discover anything about yourself and your abilities along the way? Discover anything interesting about the region that makes you want to learn more?

Part 2) **Tell us about how you see your future in the region:**

- Where will you continue your studies? What program have you signed up for? How do you see yourself in that career field, five years from now, living and working in the Townships?

WRITTEN ESSAYS

- Minimum of 500 words to a maximum of 600 words, have a title, include the word count.
- Entries must be typed using an 11 or 12-point font.
- Entries must be submitted in Microsoft Word (.doc or .docx) format.

VIDEO ESSAYS

- Entry must not exceed three minutes in length.
- Video can be shot using any kind of equipment provided the orientation is landscape/horizontal.
- Entries must be submitted via **Google Drive** or **YouTube link**.

All submissions must be original work. Each essay must be submitted along with a completed **entry form** to mwfy@townshippers.org with "Excel in the Estrie entry" in the subject line.

Submissions that do not meet the requirements or that are received after the deadline will not be considered.

Townshippers' Association/Make Way for YOUTH Estrie collects your information for the purpose of this contest. All entries become the property of Townshippers' Association and will not be returned; you will be notified if your essay has been selected as winner. The names of winners will be announced via Townshippers' Association's Facebook and Twitter accounts, local newspaper columns and at its Annual General Meeting.
