The Young Townships Leader Award (YTLA) encourages younger citizens who are actively involved in their communities by celebrating their achievements, contributions, and efforts. Established in 2006, the YTLA is presented annually to at least one Townshipper aged 15 to 35 who has shown leadership within the English-speaking community in the Eastern Townships through their actions at school, work, or in the wider community within the previous two years (24 months prior to April 30, 2020).

Thanks to our partners, YTLA recipients will be receive a \$1,000 cash prize!

Nominations for this annual award are accepted all year long and the 16th Young Townships Leaders Award will be presented at Townshippers' Association's annual general meeting in June 2020. Nominations received after April 30 will be considered for the 2021 awards.

- (4) An explanation of the nominee's accomplishments and/or contributions to the English-speaking community in the Eastern Townships in the last two years (24 months prior to April 30, 2020).
